- Ability to safely assess a situation to determine if the job is feasible
- Ability to understand and respond to hand signals
- Desire to work in all weather conditions
- Ability to safely rig and troubleshoot irregular load dynamics
- Ability to work independently or as part of a team
- Ability to pass pre-employment and DOT physical and drug screening
